Bad Debt:

It was moved by Commissioner Tumulty and seconded by Commissioner Homan to charge off from accounts receivable for account #20-40923 for \$2,387.19, as required by U.S. Bankruptcy Case#17-11984 dated 12/01/2017.

General Manager's Report:

General manager Hadden and Chairman Hull will meet with Peaker, Acentech, Tighe and Bond and the DEP on January 23rd to discuss Wilkins' approval for generation.

The Beacon transformer should be complete within the next two weeks.

The building renovation is on schedule for mid-February completion.
