Financial Report:

Finance Assistant Barrett distributed to the Commission the October 2019 Operating Statement and the November 2019 Accrued Operating Statement.

The Purchased Power Adjustment for December 2019 remains at .27 cents per Kwh for all customers.

Bad Debt:

Finance Assistant Barrett discussed the 2019 schedule of bad debts to be charged off this year. He recommended to charge off the entire schedule totaling \$22,827.68 and noted that the department will continue collection efforts on the accounts listed on the report.

Sustainable Marblehead:
